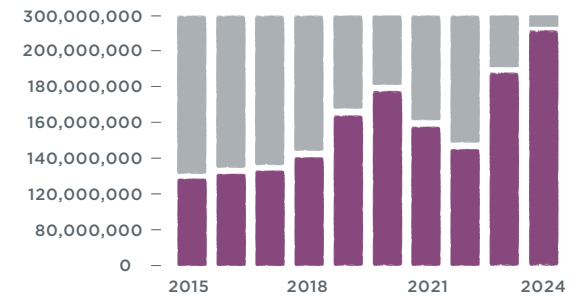

Operating Revenue

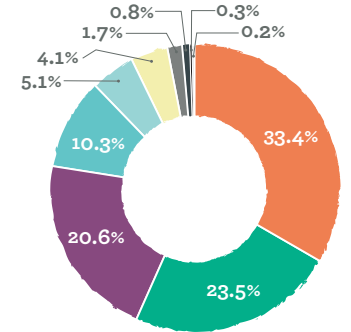


Operational Expenses

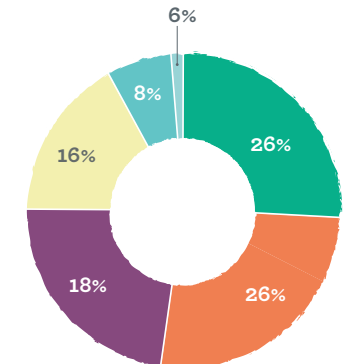

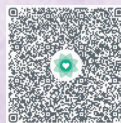
