Our experienced psychiatric, medical, and mental health professionals provide a nurturing and therapeutic experience along with a treatment plan tailored to meet the individual needs of children. We use neuroscience-based resources to teach individuals about their brains and emotions to help them develop skills to self-regulate and overcome life's challenges.

Youth Admissions

If we have the completed consent paperwork for youth, we can finalize the admission process without a parent or guardian present. If anyone has questions about Camber or the admission process, please direct them to contact our Admissions team.

Youth Outcomes Reported by Client Guardians Include:

At Camber, our work to support clients and their families aims to serve them long after they are discharged from our care. Some of the key outcomes reported by client guardians include:

- **95%** of guardians state that they feel prepared to provide for their child's needs after they complete their stay at Camber.
- **92%** of guardians report that the Camber safety plan is effective and continues to help their child at home.
- **98%** of guardians report medication compliance post-discharge.

Camber also provides residential treatment programs in Kansas.
